## **Dear Colleagues**

The South West Hospital and Health Board held its monthly meeting in Roma on Monday 24 February 2020 with some members teleconferencing due to the flood conditions across the South West. The meeting was chaired by Board Chair, Jim McGowan AM and attended by six members of the Board, Claire Alexander, Jan Chambers, Ray Chandler, Fiona Gaske and Stewart Gordon and Karen Tully (Deputy Chair).

The Board hosted a session with Associate Professor Robyn Littlewood, Chief Executive Officer and Rachel Afflick from Health and Wellbeing Queensland. Dr Littlewood provided an overview of her role and outlined her vision and work for the future.
